EZ MOUNT CB BRACKET KITS for JEEPS

EZ Mount CB Brackets for Jeep 2007 to present (2014)

Originally developed in 2007 for the JK Jeep Wrangler, the EZ Mount Bracket mounts a CB radio just above the rear view mirror. The EZ Mount bracket hardware utilizes the existing footman loop: the footman loop is a small metal bracket that is used to hold the windshield down on the hood if the windshield is ever folded forward onto the hood. There is a similar loop on the hood.

In 2009 Jeep modified the way that they retained the hardtop to the windshield. They also used the footman loop to retain the hardtop. These changes required a modification to the hardware used for the EZ Mount CB bracket. This modification became standard, allowing the EZ Mount Bracket to fit all JK model Jeeps, 2007 to present (2014):

Mounting the CB in this location keeps it out of the way and also allows it to be heard very well. An optional microphone bracket was developed to mount the microphone to the hardtop roof above the drivers head.

With the CB mounted in this position there was no readily available power supply. We developed a wiring kit that takes 12 volt 30 amp power directly from the battery. The wiring kit cleanly routes power (fused) across the firewall and along the frame to the left rear corner of the Jeep, just behind the taillight assembly. By routing 30amps of power to this area, other components can also be tapped into this power supply.

A fuse and two conductor wire is supplied to connect to this power source and a ground point. The two conductor wire is routed into the Jeep interior and installed under the roll bar padding all the way to the CB. At the CB attach the radios wires to this power source using the fuse supplied with your radio.

For Jeeps 2003 to 2006

With the success of JK bracket, a similar bracket was designed for these older Jeeps. This bracket is different from the JK bracket but also uses the footman loop and puts the radio in the same location above the mirror. The wiring kit developed for the JK also works very well for this application. (Wiring Kit 710XX970)

For Jeeps 2002 and older

A third bracket kit is available for these older Jeeps. It uses the same main stainless bracket in kit 710XX932 however it does not require the hardware in that kit. Mounting instead is accomplished by unscrewing the footman loop from the windshield frame. These screws are 10-24 x 1/2 Torx head screws, requiring a #20 driver. With the footman loop removed, align it with the holes in the stainless and using the same screws attach the bracket to the windshield frame. We have heard that some footman loops have been pop-riveted to the windshield frame, in this case the rivets would have to be drilled out and new rivets used to mount the bracket or use self-tapping screws.
